- Students often do the assigned work without realizing the purpose and value of doing this work for mastery...because it "doesn't count for marks"...so we spend significant time marking assignments...complete with comments, red circles and hopefully lots of checkmarks...most students get these back and file them...never to be viewed again...
- Using Formative Evaluation, students have an opportunity to assess their work and determine what their status is in terms of mastery of particular components of their learning...without the judgmental aspect of marks...this "Evaluation For Learning" allows students to make mistakes and learn from them...and they are the ones interacting with THEIR work...
- Samples of rubrics and the creation of rubrics for a particular set of work will occur...lots of files to share!
