The SPICE (Speech Perception Instructional Curriculum and Evaluation) kit is a program to encourage the development of listening and understanding speech in children using Cochlear Implants and hearing aids. This kit supports students from age 2 to 11 with age appropriate materials. The SPICE program is an instructional curriculum that comes with specific auditory goals and well described lessons – a user friendly program. Individuals who would benefit from this inservice are Teachers, Educational Assistants, Speech-Language Pathologists, or anyone working with a Deaf or Hard of Hearing student learning to listen effectively.

About the facilitator:

Kim Bizuk works in the Central Alberta region as an Educational Consultant for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.
